Wisdom

Wisdom, or the capacity for insight and judgment that is developed through experience,
increases between the ages of fourteen and twenty-five, then levels off.

Thus, it is during the adolescence-adulthood transition that individuals acquire
the type of wisdom that is associated with age.

Wisdom is not the same as intelligence: adolescents do not improve substantially
on IQ tests since their scores are relative to others in their same age group,
and relative standing usually does not change
- everyone matures at approximately the same rate.
